Haughley in Bloom is a Parish owned and Parish Council supported initiative, which helps to enhance the natural Haughley environment for Haughley people and visitors alike. We believe this ongoing initiative is particularly important to parishioners who have no outdoor space, or can no longer manage their gardens.

The planting of floral displays throughout the Parish and the maintenance of plant containers are the responsibility of a small, but dedicated group of volunteers, many of whom have adopted containers outside or near their homes and generously give their time and energy to take care of them.

Whenever possible, plants, peat-free compost and other essential sundry items are sourced locally to support local businesses and help maintain a sustainable community.

The new containers' planting will feature a patriotic colour scheme, which will be replicated in the usual annual summer display.
